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

Guidelines to Authors

You may submit papers proposals for the following different categories: Paper Presentation:

Content should be based on conducted research within the field of rehabilitation or any other vocational rehabilitation related area. Authors should cover research interest, findings, conclusions, and recommendations. Presentations can be for a 10 minutes' slot including 2 minutes for Q & A.

Posters Sessions:

Content should be based on conducted research within the field of rehabilitation or any other vocational rehabilitation related area. Authors should cover research interest, findings, conclusions, and recommendations. Poster session will be for a 30-minute slot including Q & A. The size of a poster should be no more than 200 cm (height) x 90 cm (width).

Professional Sessions:

Content should be based but not limited to techniques, up-to-date resources, updated assessment tools, therapeutic interventions, etc. Presentations are all targeted to be for 30 minutes, leaving 10 minutes for the audience to ask questions or discuss particular points.

Abstract Submission guidelines

Word limit for presentation titles is 20 words (in English).
Word limit for abstracts is 200 words (in English).
Abstracts cannot be modified once they have been submitted.

Extended Abstract Submission guidelines

Please follow APA guidelines for formatting. Text should be formatted for 8.5 x 11-inch paper, 12 point Times New Roman font that is single-spaced, with one inch margins and justified. References should generally follow APA style guidelines as well. Maximum length of extended abstract is 1500 words.

The following is the suggested format for paper submissions:

Paper Title

All authors' Title & Name, Affiliation, Email etc Abstract and Keywords

Introduction / Background / Objective

Methodology, Findings, Analysis & Discussion

Conclusion, Limitations and Recommendations

References - APA Style is required.
